The eventful history of Schloss Schlemmin

The roots of Schlemmin trace back to the year 1320. As early as the 14th century, the von Thun family built a moated castle on this special piece of land — a structure that was repeatedly rebuilt and transformed over the centuries.

Between 1846 and 1850, the present-day neo-Gothic manor house was constructed in the style of an English Tudor castle. It was designed by renowned Berlin architect Eduard Knoblauch on behalf of Wilhelm Ulrich von Thun.

Through marriage and inheritance,

the castle changed hands several times before eventually becoming the property of the Stolberg-Wernigerode family. But the noble era came to an end with World War II: in 1945, the Red Army occupied the area, and the castle became a refuge for displaced persons. Later, it served as a school, a local store, and eventually as a guest-house for the agricultural cooperative “Rotes Banner” in Trinwillershagen. In the 1980s, cucumbers and tomatoes were even cultivated on the grounds of the castle’s nursery — a curious chapter in the estate’s eventful history.

After German reunification, the municipality of Schlemmin took over the castle, but an initial attempt to operate it as a hotel failed. The building continued to deteriorate — until 1999, when Bremen entrepreneur Horst Sander recognized the site’s potential. He undertook extensive renovations and opened the “Parkhotel Schloss Schlemmin” in 2001.

In 2019, the hotel entered receivers-

hip due to financial difficulties and was eventually sold in 2020 to the Schweim family from Stralsund. With great dedication and investment, the current owners began a new chapter in the castle's history. They carried out comprehensive renovations — including replacing all windows — and furnished the hotel rooms in a modern, tasteful style with understated elegance. In the public areas such as hallways, staircases, the restaurant, and vaulted cellar, they preserved the historical character of various eras. Guests can now enjoy the historic ambiance in peace — whether inside the house, in the stylish restaurant and café, on the balcony, or on the terrace overlooking the park.

The 18-hectare castle park is a feast for the senses: strolling along its paths, visitors encounter ancient oaks, a

romantic linden alley, and a fruit and herb garden — as well as numerous beehives and a small Galloway cattle farm, which enriches the castle restaurant's menu with honey and organic meat.
